

157. An act to empower Jacob Summers, of C., and Lewis Ramsburg, of M., of the German Reformed Church, and William Metzger and Daniel Main, of the Lutheran Church, to sell, dispose of and convey a certain piece or parcel of land in Frederick co'y.

158. An act to incorporate the Board of Trade of the City of Baltimore.

159. An act for the completion of the unfinished business on the law side of Baltimore County Court sitting for City business.

160. An act entitled, an act dispensing with ten hoops on barrels of flour brought from other States.

161. A bill entitled, an act in addition to the act to incorporate the Locust Point Steam Ferry Company of Maryland, passed at December session, 1849, chapter 34.

162. An act to incorporate the Anne Arundel Steam Ferry Company of Maryland.

163. An act to make valid the acknowledgment of a deed from Christian Newcomer and others to Christian Myers.

164. An act in addition to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Swanton Coal and Iron Company, passed at December session, 1849, chapter 153.

165. An act to make valid a deed from Charles H. Carroll, of the State of New York, executor of the last will and testament of Charles Carroll, deceased, to James Reynolds of Montgomery county.

166. An act to cure a defect in the acknowledgment of a deed from John Richardson and wife, of the State of Indiana, to Sydnium H. Mills, of Worcester county.

167. An act to amend the charter of the President and Directors of the Associated Firemen's Insurance Company of Baltimore.

168. An act for the better regulation of primary schools in Carroll county.

169. An act to provide for payment of expenses occasioned by the removal of civil causes.

170. An act authorising the Orphans' Court of Worcester county to complete the record of proceedings of the late Orphans' Court of said county.

171. An act to provide for laying out into avenues, streets, lanes and alleys, and public reservations, the Western Liberties of Baltimore county.

172. An act to designate the persons before whom oaths of office shall be taken and subscribed.

173. An act to authorise the Clerks of Courts to make orders and to issue commissions in equity cases, and to adjourn court in certain cases.

174. An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Dorchester county, to be called election district number ten, or Strait's Neck district.
