

211. An act to change the name of Francis Wakeman Carr, of Harford county, to that of Francis Carr Smith.

212. An act to establish another grade in the inspection of flour in the City of Baltimore.

213. An act to provide for the payment of Nicholas Brewer for his services as Chancellor of this State.

214. An act to regulate the sessions of the Circuit Courts in the fourth judicial circuit.

215. An act to establish the terms of the Superior Court and of the Court of Common Pleas of Baltimore city, and to make valid the terms of said Courts already held.

216. An act to authorise the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard county to deliver to Thomas Brice Hobbs his commission as Register of Wills of said county, without requiring any additional tax.

217. An act to authorise the Circuit Court for Worcester county to appoint a trustee to execute a conveyance of certain real estate of Robert J. H. Handy, deceased, to Chesed Purnell.

218. An act to establish an additional election district in Allegany county.

219. An act to provide for the final disposition of undecided cases pending in the district Courts.

220. An act to extend the time of certain collectors to complete their collections.

221. An act to incorporate Cemetery Companies.

222. An act to change the place of holding elections in election district, number three, or the lower election district of Caroline county.

223. An act to create a new election district in Washington county.

224. An act to purchase copies of the Maryland Chancery reports for the use of the Courts of each county, and for the benefit of the State Library.

225. An act entitled, an act regulating the fees of Sheriffs of Allegany county for taking prisoners from the County Jail to the State's Prison.

226. An act to provide for the collection of State and County taxes in arrears in Baltimore county.

227. An act for the completion of the unfinished business of Baltimore County Court as a Court of Equity, so far as the same relates to the City of Baltimore.

228. An act to authorise the Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy on said county a sum sufficient to pay the additional expenses incurred in holding the second inquisition over the body of Joseph C. Miller, late of Pennsylvania.

229. An act to amend an act entitled, an act for the protection of miners, mechanics, laborers and others employed in mines and manufactories in the County of Allegany, and for other purposes, passed December session, 1847, chapter 228.
