261. An act to crect a new election district in Frederick county, out of parts of number three and number six election districts.

262. An act entitled, an act to provide for the payment to Samuel F. Stonestreet, late Clerk of Montgomery County Court, for fees due him from the State.

263. An act to provide for carrying into effect the fifth section of the fourth article of the constitution.

264. An act to establish a new school district, out of a part of primary school district, number twenty-nine, of Howard county.

265. An act for the benefit of the owners of the steamboat

Osiris.

266. An act to authorise and empower the president, managers and company of the Boonsborough Turnpike Road Company to grade, occupy and change, if necessary, the public road leading from Sharpsburg to the Potomae river, and to charge toll thereon.

267. An act to authorise the Mayor, Aldermen, and Common Council of Frederick to borrow money on the credit of said corporation, for the purpose of introducing an additional supply of water into said city.

268. An act authorising the sale or lease of certain property in the eastern part of the City of Baltimore, belonging to the Society of Friends, or people called Quakers, in the said city.

269. An act to refund to John S. Ensor, former collector of State taxes for the eighth election district of Baltimore county, a sum of money therein named, being an overpayment into the treasury for the years 1845 and 1846.

270. An act to refund to Mrs. E. J. Eldridge, of Montgomery county, a sum of money therein named, being an overpayment on

license.

271. An act for the relief of Upton Scott, of Carroll county.

272. An act to lay off and locate a public road in Howard

county.

273. An act for the relief of the devisees of Doctor John Stevenson, late of Worcester county, deceased, and those claiming, by, from, or under them, and to make valid the report of John U. Dennis and other commissioners, to divide the real estate of said deceased.

274. An act to fix the number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for each ward of the City of Baltimore, and for each

election district in the several counties of this State.

275. An act for running and marking the western boundary line

of this State.

276. An act to provide a more effectual punishment for the violation of the ordinances passed by the Burgess and Commissioners of the Town of Williamsport in Washington county.

277. An act to amend the charter of the Baltimore Orphan

Asylum.
