Value of Property assigned to Baltimore County.

DIVISION No. 1.—That part of the old Tobacco Warehouse, Lot marked D, Division No. 1, fronting 120 feet on Philpot street, by a depth of 70 feet binding on Point street..... \$3,000 00

Together with the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to be paid them by the City to equalize the valuation of Lot C..... 750 00

DIVISION No. 2.—The sum of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars to be paid by the City to Baltimore County, for their *one-half* interest in Jail property of every description, per exhibit C, and plat herewith..... 17,500 00

DIVISION No. 3.—The sum of ninety-two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars to be paid by the City to Baltimore County, for their *one-half* interest in the Court House and Record Office and ground attached thereto as per valuation in exhibit C, and per plat herewith..... 92,750 00

DIVISION No. 4.—Of the *Alms House* property we allotted to Baltimore County the following portion comprising Lots Nos. 5, 6 and 7, beginning at B, on the plat, it being at the end of the fourth line of the part of said land allotted to the City of Baltimore, and running thence binding on said part to 5 in the centre of the Franklin Turnpike road, then running along the centre of said road 315 feet to the centre of the Bridge over Gwinn's Run at 6 on the plat, then running southwardly along the centre of said Run to the southern line of the Alms House ground at 7 on the plat, then running and bounding on the outlines of said ground to 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 to B, the beginning, containing exclusively of that part of the Franklin Turnpike road, laying within the limits of the ground above described, one hundred and fifty-eight acres, three quarters of an acre and two square perches of land more or less and valued in Division C, No. 4, and exhibit C, herewith, including buildings thereon..... \$72,136 87½
