Also, by a deed from John Eager Howard, Josias Pennington and James Ogleby, to Baltimore County, dated the 4th day of August, 1802, and recorded in Liber W. G., No. 73, folio 656, &c.

And by a deed from Nicholas Ruxton Moore to Samuel Owings and others, the Commissioners aforesaid for the use of Baltimore County, dated the 11th day of December 1799, and recorded in

Liber W. G., No. 62, folio 33, &c.

Third. The Poor House property embraces the entire tract of land containing 302 acres, more or less, which was conveyed by the President and Directors of the Mechanics Bank of Baltimore, to the Trustees for the Poor of Baltimore City and County, by Indenture bearing date the 26th day of June, 1835, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County, in Liber T. K.,

No. 250, folio 44, &c.

Fourth. Besides the foregoing property there appears upon the records a deed from Deter Barger to the Trustees of the Poor House of Baltimore County, dated the 30th day of April 1821, (see Liber W. G., No. 160, folio 11, &c.,) for three lots of ground designated on the plat, of that part of Chatsworth formerly belonging to Solomon Etting, by the numbers 97,98 and 99 together, fronting 75 feet on the south-west side of Division street, commencing 175 feet south-eastwardly from Lanvile street, and extending back 100 feet to Brewer formerly Tripe alley; no deed was found on record conveying the title to these lots out of the said Trustees.

Fifth. The old Tobacco Inspection Warehouse on Fells' Point. For this property no title was found after a diligent

search.
