Resolved, That the chairman be requested to call on the chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Alms House, for a complete inventory of all the personal property of every kind, in and on the Alms House property.

Resolved, That the chairman call on the chairman of the Board of Visitors of the Jail, for an inventory of all the personal

property of every description belonging to said Jail.

On motion of Mr. Keener,

Resolved, That we take up the Tobacco Warehouse lot next, which was unanimously agreed to.

On motion of Mr. Bernard,

That the old Tobacco Warehouse property be divided by a line drawn through the centre of the said lot. Beginning at the distance of 70 feet south from the south east intersection of Block and Point streets, and 70 feet north from north east corner of Philpot and Point streets, and designated by the letter A, and running parallel with Block and Philpot streets, to the letter B, as on the Plat, which was unanimously agreed to.

On motion of Mr. Keener,

The Commissioners adjourned until to-morrow morning at 10 o'clock.
