

FORM OF A TABLE

From the Board of School Commissioners to the Secretary of State.

This table is intended to show the form of a report from the Board of School Commissioners of the several Counties to the Secretary of State, and the manner in which it might be made out. If this, or some similar form be adopted, it will annually exhibit the condition of the Schools in each County, and at the same time present a detailed account of the system throughout the State. If the Trustees of each of the school districts report, annually, to the Board of Commissioners of their respective Counties, as they are directed in the bill, the labor of preparing the report would be comparatively light.
