\* At the time of balancing the account of Henry C. Rawlings, Register of Wills for Caroline county, to September 30th, 1853, he was charged with the tax upon his office for six months, ending November 1st, 1852, amounting to \$37 50. Since then, it has been ascertained, that Mr. Rawlings was appointed to office in August, 1852, and should, therefore, have been charged for the tax for three months only, amounting to \$18 75. The account of his predecessor in office should have been charged with the tax for the three months preceding, which has now been done, and the balance of \$18 75, due by Mr. Rawlings, has been paid as above stated.
