times, she calls upon the other members of the confederacy, in the spirit of patriotic conciliation, to unite with her in cementing anew

the foundations of our common nationality.

Resolved, That copies of the preambles and resolutions, certified by the Secretary of State, be transmitted by His Excellency the Governor, to the Senators and Representaives of this State in Congress, to be laid before the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States, and to the Governors of the several States and Territories of the Union, to be laid before the legislative authorities thereof.
