You make oath on the Holy Evangely, of Almighty God, that the specie funds which you shall exhibit to be counted by the special committee, appointed by the House of Delegates, are bona fide funds of this Bank, that none of said specie has been borrowed or hired for a temporary or special purpose, or belongs to any other banking institution, or has been desposited to the credit of any person or persons as special depositors.

And the committee proceeded to count the same, and the following statement will show the result, together with the other assets and the affairs of the Bank.

Cross examination of P. D. Burgher.

1st. Interogatory: He had in April 1855; this respondent told Dr. H. Roussett that Mr. Waggoner requested him to sign the \$5 notes, and have Mr. Bradley sign the \$10 notes, he said he was willing to have him sign them.

2nd Interrogatory: He knows that he signed over twenty-seven thousand dollars of tens prior to the first of May.
