 but has been told by John Gibb she was born at Edinburgh
 and was daughter to one Mr. Cleland a Merchant there
 who having broke was afterwards Captain of the Town
 Guard and that she had some Fortune left to her and
 says that he knows not how long Janet Cleland has
 been in Maryland but has known her live at different
 Times with her Uncle John Gibb and has heard some
 times of her being at Philadelphia since his death
 and that she has been sometimes at his the Deponents
 house, but knows not how employed only believes
 as other Women in her Station and also saith that he
 has often spoke to John Gibb concerning the Libellant
 when he told him that he knew he not only ought
