In pursuance whereof His Honour the Judge
 made the following Rule or Order and Interst on
 the Back of the said Petition

By the Commissary General January 10th 1750
 Although the within Petition was not exhibited till
 after the Issue was joyn'd in the Cause therein mentioned
 the Depositions of the Witnesses Examined in Virtue of a
 Commission regularly issued for that purpose at the
 Instance of all the parties in the said Cause and the
 Probation of Losses yet to prevent the Petitioners being
 hindered or barred of shewing any Right they may have
 and having all just and legal Advantage and benefit
 thereof and to prevent the Determination of such Right
 unheard the Commissary doth rule and order that the
 Petitioners have time till next March Court to produce
 such Witnesses or Witnesses as they shall think fit or be
 advised to Prove the Allegations of their Petition and
 that upon Proof being of the Sickness or Inability of
 any Witnesses or Witnesses which the Petitioners may be
 desirous to Examine to attend the Court that a Commission
