

The Deposition of John Donaldson of Hart
County Plaster aged fifty years who being duly and
solemnly sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty
God to the first Interrogatory Depose that he saith
that he knows the Parties Libellant & Respondants
that he has known the Libellant upwards of three
years and the Respondents Twelve years

To the second Interrogatory saith that he knew
John Gibb the Respondants Testator Twelve years
before his death and that he believes the said John
Gibb died in the year 1747

To the third & fourth Interrogatories saith that he
knows nothing of them

To the fifth Interrogatory saith that he saw &
conversed with the said John Gibb some short time
before or after harvest in the year the said John Gibb
died concerning the disposition of his estate that he
asked the said John Gibb whether he had made a Will
and what Provision he had made for his Neice Janet
Celand who answered that she had made several Wills
and that he had given the said Janet Celand a charter
to hang herself and afterwards said that he had given

but did not hear him say that he intended to set his
Negroes free

To the sixth Interrogatory saith that he saw
the Libellant Janet Celand at the house of the said
John Gibb in his last sickness but does not know
whether she lived there or not nor does he know
