to the first Interrogatory deposeth and saith that he  
knows the parties Libellant and Respondants that he  
has known the Libellant fourteen years that he has known  
the Respondent James Mafsey as long as he has known  
any Body and the other Respondent John Hadley  
Seventeen or eighteen Years

To the second Interrogatory saith that he know  
John Gibb the Respondents Testator and had known  
him fifteen or sixteen years before his death and that  
he died in the Month of October in the year 1747—

To the third Interrogatory saith that he was present  
and saw the said John Gibb sign and Seal and heard  
him publish and declare a Will to be his last Will &  
Testament that his Name subscribed as a Witness  
to the said Will is his own handwriting that he wrote  
it in the presence of the said John Gibb the Testator  
that James Mafsey John Hadley John Morris Thomas  
Hadley John Spry Robert Hadley and the Libellant  
James Cleland were all present when the Testator
