To the fourth Interrogatory saith that the Will now

appeared to this deponent to be perfectly in his senses
when he did so sign publish and declare the said Will
and that he believes the said Will is all of the hand
writing of John Morris for that he saw him write the
latter part of it.

To the fifth Interrogatory saith that he several
times saw and conversed with the said John Gibb in
his health and in his last sickness but does not remember
the Particulars of such conversation nor does he remember
to have heard him say any thing about the disposition
of his Estate.

To the sixth Interrogatory saith she did live in the house and family of the said John
Gibb a considerable time but does not remember
exactly how long that she left him and went to live
at Philadelphia but does not know upon what
Occasion that he once saw the said John Gibb
displeas'd with her in his last sickness when she
offer'd to lift his Leggs upon his Bed as he lay down
calling her dogg or Bogue and bidding her begone for
that she was always a plaguing him and he did not
want her in his sight and that he does not know that
