 this Respondent James Maffey for himself saith that he hath
 used all his Endeavours to reconcile the Testator to the Libellant
 but to no Purpose, and that a Day or two before the Executing
 the Testators last Will he the Testator sent for a certain John
 Holt to write his Will, and ordered the said John Holt to Trans-
 cribe a Will that had been formerly drawn for him by one Bennett
 a Lawyer which the said John Holt as this Respondent believes
 did with some alteration but upon the Testators reading the said
 Will he found that two Thousand Pounds of Tobacco was left to
 the Libellant which he appeared displeas'd at and said that he
 would not sign it for that he Intended to sett the Libellant
 off with a Shilling and that he would send for some other Person
 for he suspected the said John Holt was too much Inclined to
 Draw a Will in favour of the Libellant or words to that Effect
 and these Respondents say that the Testator sent for a certain
 John Morris who wrote the said Testators Will at his Request,
 and that the same signed Sealed Published and Delivered by
 him in the Presence of the subscribing Witnesses to it at the
 express request of the s^d Testator, and in the Presence of the Libellant
 without that that any other matter or thing in the said Libellants
 Libell contained Material or Effectual for these Respondents to
 make answer unto and not herein before answered unto Confessed
 or Avoided traversed or Denied, is true all which matters and things
 these Respondents are Ready to aver maintain and prove as
