Depositions of Witnesses taken at Abraham Falconer of Kent County on Sunday the Eighth day of November In the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and fifty and on the nineteenth and Twelfth days of November a^d by Virtue of a Commission Issued out of his Lordships Prerogative Court to us and Edward Cynegys and John Carville of Kent County or any two of us directed for the Examination of Witnesses in a Cause therein depending between Janet Cleland Libellant and James Mafsey Sen. and John Hadley Jun^r Executors of John Gibb Respondents.

The Deposition of John Meconskin of Queen Anne County Planter aged fifty seven years or thereby who being sworn and Interrogated upon Interrogatories given in by the Libellant and signed by Daniel Dulany Jun^r saith as follows

As to the first Interrogatory that he hath known Janet Cleland about three years or upwards and that she lived three Months with him about the Time of John Gibb de^{ce}ased his Death and that he has known the a^d John Mafsey and James Hadley for more than twenty three years

And as to the second Interrogatory saith that he has known John Gibb de^{ce}ased for more than twenty three years and that John Gibb died about the Eighteenth Day of October in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and forty Seven -

As to the Third Interrogatory saith that he never saw John Gibb make Seal nor deliver any Writing or Writings purporting his last Will or Wills

As to the fourth Interrogatory saith that when he last saw the a^d John Gibb being about Ten Days before his Death he did not believe him to be of perfect sound and disposing mind and Memory

As to the fifth Interrogatory saith that he does not think the said John Gibb de^{ce}ased was in his Senses a little before his Death at least about ten Days having conversed with him for some time
