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The Deposition of William Carmichael of Queen Anns County aged fifty one or thereby who being Sworn and Interrogated upon the Interrogatories afft. saith as follows that he has known the Parties Libellant and Respondents for some years and John Gibb for at least ten years before his Death but knows nothing of his signing Sealing or Delivering any Will and he saith that he does not thinke that John Gibb in his most perfect health was either perfect or sound of mind having with several others company seen and been diverted with his extravagant Whims and follies In particular he used to boast of his great Judgment learning and understanding tho' at same time the Deponeant thinks he was quite void of all of them and further saith that he used to boast of his Bodily perfections such as Strength Comeliness & and of the great Power he had in Charming
