Gibb and Janet Cleland come ashore at the time he arrived from Scotland
and John Gibb being asked if Janet Cleland was his Wife made answer
that she was his Niece and that he had made her give all she had to
his Brother in Scotland and that he was to make her his Heir in
Maryland
