

that the Petitioners have time till next March Court to produce such Witnesses or Witnesses as they shall think fitt or be Advised to prove the Allegations of their Petition and that upon Proof being made of the Sickness or Inability of any Witness or Witnesses which the Petitioners may be desirous to examine and attend the Court that a Commission immediately Issue to a proper Person or Persons to take the Deposition or Depositions of such Witness or Witnesses and that such Deposition or Depositions (timely Notice being given to the Libellant or her Proctor or Advocate of the time and Place when and where such Deposition or Depositions shall be taken) shall avail the Petitioners as much as if they had been Parties in the Cause and the Depositions had been taken in Virtue of the Commission already mentioned saving to the Libellant the right of Producing any Evidence she can to Contradict or Invalidate the Evidence on the Part of the Petitioners Provided the Witnesses shall be Produced and the Deposition or Depositions (if any shall be) be returned so as the Cause may be finally heard and determined next March Court of which Rule let the parties or their Proctors or Advocates have Immediate Notice
