✕ To the eighth Interrogatory this Deponent saith that he is Father to John Thompson Legatee in the Will of John Gibb de'd mentioned that the Libellant about the twelfth day of November last agreed with this Deponent that in case he would not Interpose in the Suit now depending she (in case the Will should be set aside) would Relinquish her to the Legacy given by the said Will to the Son of this Deponent and thereupon Cap^t John Legar Connelius Comegys Charles Gordon and William Comegys Jun^r and the Widow Gilbert Galioner de'd who were then present were desired to take Notice of this Agreement

To the ninth Interrogatory this Deponent saith that he has often heard the said John Gibb boast of his Bodily strength and the Beauty of his Person and that Women frequently fell in Love with him (since the Death of his Wife) but how long since or before his own Death does not remember, that the said John Gibb at the time of such Boasting to the best of this Deponents Judgment was in his Senses and Capable of making a Will or of buying what he wanted or of selling what he had to spare without being Cheated or imposed upon.
