The Deposition of John Donaldson of Kent County Planter aged fifty years who being duly and solemnly sworn on the holy Evangel of Almighty God to the first Interrogatory deposed and saith that he knows the Parties Libellant and Respondents that he has known the Libellant upwards of three years & the Respondent Twelve years

To the second Interrogatory saith that he knew John Gibb the Respondents Testator twelve years before his Death and that he believes the said John Gibb Died in the year 1747

To the third & fourth Interrogatories saith that he knows nothing of them

To the fifth Interrogatory saith that he saw and conversed with the said John Gibb some short time before or after Harvest in the year the said John Gibb Died concerning the Disposition of his Estates that he asked the said John Gibb whether he had made a Will and what provision he had made for his Neice Janet Cleland who answered that he had made several Wills and that he had given the said Janet Cleland a halter to hand herself and afterward said ^{that} he had given her two Hogsheds of Tobacco or words to the same Effect but did not hear him say that he Intended to set his Negroes free
