present when the Testator did sign Seal and publish the said

To the Fourth Interrogatory saith that the Will now
produced and shewn to him is the very Will that he saw the
said John Gibb sign and Seal and which he heard the said
John Gibb Publish as his last Will and Testament that in
his Deponents Opinion the said John Gibb was perfectly in
his Senses when he did so sign seal and Publish the said Will
and that he believes the said Will is all of the hand writing of
John Morris This Deponent further saith that after the Will
was wrote which was in the Evening of the same Day it was Executed
James Mapsey one of the Respondents told the said John
Gibb that his Will was ready and asked him if he would sign
it then or let it alone till Morning to which the said John Gibb
answered to night for I am very weak and low and I do not
know how soon it may please God that I may depart and the
said John Gibb called his Negro Woman Hannah and bid her
