To the Second Interrogatory saith that she knew John Gibb the Respondents Testator and had known him thirty years before his Death and that the said John Gibb died in the Month of October in the Year 1747.

To the fifth Interrogatory saith she did see and converse wth the said John Gibb many times before his Death, that about six months before the said John Gibbs last Sickness she told the said John Gibb that he would grease some Body in the Urse with his Negroes when he died to which the said John Gibb answered that he would not for they were his Children and he had no other Children and that he would leave them his lands to live upon

To the Sixth Interrogatory saith that the Libellant lived several times in the house and family of the said John Gibb but never long at a time, that she often left him and went to live at Philadelphia which the said John Gibb charged to her ill Temper and said it was im possible for any Man to live with her that she does not know that the Libellant did Increase the said John Gibbs Estate but has heard him say that he had sent her several Hayheads of Tobacco to Philadelphia
