 the first Interrogatory deposeth and saith that she knowes Parties  
 Libellant and Respondents that she has known the Libellant fif-  
 teen years James Mapsey twenty years and the other Respondent  
 John Hadley about Sixteen Years

To the Second Interrogatory saith that she knew John Gibb  
 the Respondents Testator and had known him thirty years before  
 his Death and that the said John Gibb died in the Month of October  
 in the Year 1747.

To the fourth Interrogatory saith she knows not.

To the fifth Interrogatory saith she did see and conversed  
 with the said John Gibb many times before his Death, that about  
 six months before the said John Gibbs last sickness she told the  
 said John Gibb that he would grieve some Body in the Arse with  
 his Negros when he died to which the said John Gibb answered  
 that he would not for they were his Children and he had no other  
 Children and that he would leave them his lands to live upon.

To the Sixth Interrogatory saith that the Libellant lived several  
 times in the house and family of the said John Gibb but never long at  
 a time, that she often left him and went to live at Philadelphia which  
 the said John Gibb charged to her ill Temper and said it was im-  
 possible for any Man to live with her that she does not know that the Lib-  
 lant did increase the said John Gibbs Estate but has heard him say  
 that he had sent her several Hogsheads of Tobacco to Philadelphia
