review the Ballance of that Account allowing him his Commission
and you are annually to return to this Board the Debt Books
so delivered up to you by the several Treasurers.

15th His Lordships Tenants being bound to pay their Rents at
the two most usual Feasts in the year, that is at Lady day
and Michaelmas by even and equal Portions it is therefore
thought reasonable that the Treasurers (who are to make a
complete Settlement but once a year) should make a partial,
or intermediate, Payment of one third of the Gross amount of
the Debt Books you are therefore annually to call upon
them to make such Payment, on or about the 25th Day of
July. and whereas Arrears may be still due from some
of the late Treasurers, whose Bonds may not as yet be put
in Suit, you are in such Case to apply to the Revenue Office
for such Bonds and Order the Attorney General, or his Pro-
secutor, to proceed thereon.

16th You are to transmit His Lordships from time to time
such Bills of Exchange as you shall receive for his Use
with Lists attending them, the List Lists by one Ship, and
the second, of the same Lists, by another Ship.

17th You are to inform and transmit all matters, that
do or shall appertain to the Execution of your Office of
Agent and Receiver General, to Hugh Hammerley Esq^r His
Lordships Secretary residing in London.

18th A Reserve being laid on all Vacant Land that now is,
or shall or may hereafter be found within the City of,
Annapolis and Town of Baltimore or within five Miles
round the said City and Town, be it by Escheat or otherwise, you
are not to do any Act, that may affect these Lands without
