Ordered That a Reserve be laid, for His Lordships use on
all Vacant and Escheat Land lying and being in the Town of Baltimore,
in Baltimore County, or within the Distance of Seven Miles thereof,
or of any part thereof, of which you are desired to make an Entry
on Record, and to take the greatest Care to prevent any Survey
being made within the same, either by expressly mentioning
the Reserve in all Warrants to be issued out of the Office or in
such other manner as may make the same known and remove
all pretence of Ignorance.

There being large Tracts of Land Reserved for the Indians
which the English have encroached upon made surveys and
got Grants of them and deny the payment of Quit Rents, alledging
that they hold of the Indians - His Lordship hath therefore directed
all these Reserves into Manors of which you are to take Notice
