

Receiver General, and the said Mr. Allen hath not given the usual Security for the due Discharge, and Performance of the Duties of the Agents Office, and especially as he hath refused to comply with the Order of this Board bearing Date the 21st Instant, and sets up a Claim of being exempted from the Authority of the Governor in respect of his Continuance in Office: It is the Opinion of the Board that Mr. Allen ought to be immediately superseded by His Excellency, and some other Person appointed Agent in the said Mr. Allen's Place, such as His Excellency shall think qualified for the same, the Agent to be appointed, giving Security as hath been heretofore done for the due Discharge and Performance of the Duties of his Office and it is further the Opinion of the Board that Mr. Allen be also called upon to render a full Account of all his Transactions in the Office of Agent from the time of his Appointment to the time of his being superseded, and that in Case of his Refusal so to do, that the Attorney General be directed to put his Bond in Suit.

His Excellency having thought proper to Nominate Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer, Esq^r for the Office of Agent and Receiver General in the room of the Rev^d Mr. Allen. The said Nomination was approved of by the Board
