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Belief, received Quit Rents for any Lands that are not contained in the said Debt Book, nor other Rents than are therein charged and that he knows of no Tracts of Land in said County, Patented Improved or Occupied, beside those which are Entered in the said Debt Book, and that the only Persons by him employed to assist in collecting the Quit Rents in the said County were

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which Assistants had severally taken a similar Oath

This Book so returned by the Receiver you are to compare with the Book you delivered him; you are then to State an Account Debiting the Receiver with the Gross Amount of said Debt Book, so adjusted, and giving him Credit for the several and particular Allowances he is intitled to from his Commission, or Instructions therewith delivered by His Excellency the Governor. Three fair Draughts of which stated Account shall be prepared and sign'd by both Parties. One of which you are to take and deliver to His Lordships Agent and another to the Clerk of the Revenue Board.

6<sup>th</sup> Should the Receivers claim Allowances that are not expressly mentioned in their Instructions, you are not to allow them, unless directed so to do by the Revenue Board, to whom all disputes between you and the Receivers are to be submitted.

7<sup>th</sup> If the Receivers do not return Books and settle their Accounts with you on or before the day appointed by their Agreement, you are within six days after the expiration of such time to signify in Writing under your Hand to the Board the Delinquency of such Receivers, and you are in like manner to inform the Board of every Officer who shall not do his Duty in making the proper Returns to your Office.

8<sup>th</sup> For all which Services as before enumerated His Lordships Agent is to pay you five per cent Commission on the net Balance of each Receivers account that shall be settled and sign'd by you.
