Instructions to the Commissary General.

- 1st You are to return to the Revenue Office a list of all Devises, when the Wills are proved in the Prerogative Office, and likewise the lists which shall in virtue of the Instructions to them be transmitted to you from time to time by the Deputy Commissaries of the several Counties.
- 2^d When a Will is brought to you for Probate, you are to enquire who is the Devisor His at Law what Lands by Name, that belonged to him, are not disposed of by the Will, and when the Lands devised are not named; you are to enquire what is the Patent Name of such Land.
- 3^d You are to transmit to the Deputies of the several Counties respectively the Instructions of the Board on this Head, and upon Death or Removal to send the same to the new Deputy, with your Commission appointing him to the Office of Deputy Commissary.

Instructions to each Deputy Commissary

- 1st When a Will is brought to you for Probate, you are to enquire who is the Devisor His at Law, what Lands by Name, that belonged to him, are not disposed of by the Will, and when the Lands devised are not named, you are to enquire what is the Patent Name of such Land.
- 2^d You are to make out a list of all Lands devised by the Wills proved before you, and transmit with the Wills, the said List to the Prerogative Office, whenever you make your Returns. You shall also at the same time, send all the information you can collect, respecting the Matters contained in the first Instruction.
