A Copy of the above Order to be likewise sent to Mr. James Everett the present Steward, in order that he may assist Mr. Calder in the above Enquiry.

Sundry Persons having preferred Petitions for leases on his Lordships Reserve in Baltimore County, the same are postponed until his Lordships Measure shall be signified in what manner the said Reserve is to be disposed of.
