The Board take under consideration the propriety of adopting a measure for the encouragement of ^{settlers} the back Inhabitants as may have settled & made small Improvements, and are unanimously of Opinion; that his Excellency the Governor hath a Power, agreeable to Instructions from the late Proprietor to the Judges of the Land office (a copy of which they are to furnish) to order Warrants to issue for small parcels of Land, not exceeding one hundred acres each, to be surveyed for those as shall apply therefor, with the Indulgence of making payment of the Compo- sition Money & other Charges at any time within Two years from the Date of such Warrants.

It is the Opinion of this Board that a proviso be inserted in all grants that may issue for Lands to the Westward of Port Cumberland effectually to make void such part or parts thereof as shall be found situated lying and being within any of the Lord Proprietors reserved Lands in that part of the Province.

On further examination of the Agents accounts with the Executors of the late Lord Proprietor, the Board unanimously pass the same _____
