

Administration where there is any Sum or order upon account ten pound of Tobacco

To the Clerk of the Peace or on the registering any Court for the drawing up being entering or certifying of any matter upon Record five pound of Tobacco.

To the Sheriff or Marshal or Officer of any Court for serving of any ordinary writ or for an imprisonment ten pound of Tobacco for issuing a writ of Execution upon body or goods ten pound of Tobacco (if the same be great exceed not five hundred weight of Tobacco) and if it be then two pound of Tobacco for every hundred weight levied by the execution For warning of the Jury three pound of Tobacco for every cause tried by the Jury to be paid by the party on whose side the verdict goeth

To the Marshall for laying by the halles ten pound of Tobacco for rhypping a Mallefactor twenty pound of Tobacco for drumming in the hand or mutilation of a member fytte pound of Tobacco for inflicting paine of Death one hundred pound of Tobacco to be paid out of the Estate of the party punished or corrected if sufficient dyshegs may be had or otherwise by the Quater of the Province upon the account of the Province

To each of the Sergeants or Marshalls of Sr. Maires or Sr. Georges band two pound of Tobacco yearly per head to be paid by every house hee per of either of those bands for him or her self and for every one within his or her familie able to be armed and to the Sergeant or Marshall of the Sale of Hunt four pound per head

To the Surveyor twenty pound of Tobacco for every hundred acres within the Shott Surveyed if it be above one hundred acres or otherwise half a pound of Tobacco for every acre Surveyed if it be under one hundred acres Provided that the
