

Generall and Councill. And Be it further  
 Enacted that all charges necessary for the appoy-  
 =ment of felons or for the imprisonment or main-  
 =tenance of delinquents or holding the prisoners  
 =request or buying of the dead body shall be de-  
 =frayed out of the goods and chattells of such  
 =felon delinquent or partie owed by the Governor  
 and if there be not sufficient sufficient there  
 they shall be defrayed by the said questor who  
 shall put it to the accompt of the province and  
 every one thereof. in any such publick ac-  
 =petition so that he be disabled to work shall  
 be put to cure by the Quator and till he be cured  
 or otherwise able to work shall be maintained  
 upon the publick charge  
 And the said Quator or Treasurer shall  
 at the first Generall Assembly next after  
 such expedition or expeditions made or other-  
 =wise at the first County Court in October make  
 and give in upon record an accompt of all his  
 disbursements and so much as shall be allowed  
 thereof by the said Assembly or otherwise by the said  
 Lieutenant Generall and Councill at the said  
 County Court shall be layed upon all the Seaboard  
 =parishes of the Province rateably to their personal  
 Estates in such manner and after such pro-  
 =portions as the said Generall Assembly or the  
 said Lieutenant Generall and Councill shall  
 rate and taxe the same This Act to continue  
 till the end of the next Generall Assembly
