- Generall and Councille shall be further
Instructed that all charges made by the appre-
hending of felons or for the impouerment or pun-
ishment of delinquents or holding the Coroners
Enquest or burying of the dead body shall be:
- payed out of the goods and chattells of such
felon delinquent or partie execued by the Coroner
and if there be not sufficiente to pay them
they shall be defrayed by the said questrours
shall putt to the accompt of the province and
