likewise all offences of willfull burning or destroy-
ing a house or stack of Tobacco (corn or hay of another
mans or of cutting or plucking out anothers eyes
or tongue And the offender (whether principall or
accessary afor that offence committed) in any of
these shall or may be Judged to Suffer paines of
death or of burning in the hand or losse of member
or to lose all his or her Landes for life goods or
Chattells dignity or Office or may be outlawed
exiled imprisoned duringe life or adjudged to
Sewe the Lord Proprietary and his assignes for
the terme of 7 or lesse years (except he be a Gentle-
man) or may be otherwise corporally punished
or put to shame as the Court shall thinke the same
to deserve This Act to endure till the end of the
next Assembly

An Act for punishment of some offences not
Capitall

Every person striking any officer Juror or
Witness in presence of the Court or striking any
other person with a drawne weapon in presence
of the Court or striking any Magistrate or high
Sheriffe of a County in or for the doing of his
Office or counterfeiting the hand or signe on a
nual or any of the Seals of the Lord Proprieta-
rie and using such counterfeiting hand or Seale
within his Lordships Jurisdiction to the pre-
judice of another or willfull falsifying corrup-
ting or embafelling of a record or giving false
witness upon oath in Court or perswading or
buyeing another to give such false witness may
be judged to lose his or her right hand or to be
burned in the hand or to any other corporall
