And doe hereby submit and oblige us our  
heirs and posterities for ever untill the last  
drop of our blood be spent to maintain  
uphold and defend Your Lordship and Your  
heirs Lords & proprietaries of this Province  
in all the Royall Rights Juris dicons Authori-  
ties and preheminences given granted and  
Confirmed unto Your Lordship by the said  
grant and donacon so far as they do not in  
any sorte infringe or prejudice the just &  
lawfull liberties or priviledges of the free born  
Subjects of the Kingdom of England And wee  
humbly beseech Your Lordship to accept the  
same as the first frutes in this assembly  
of our fidelity & thankfullness to your Lord-  
ship and Your heirs and posterity forever  
which if Your Lordship shall be pleased to  
accept and ratifye by Your assent without  
which it can neither be compleate & perfect  
nor remayne to posterity according to our  
humble desire as a Memoriall of Your Lord-  
ships affections towards us wee shall add  
this also to the rest of the unspeakable bene-  
fits We have receed by Your Lordships Vigilancy over  
this Colony
