An Act of Oblivion.

 The Lord Proprietary is willing that it should
 be enacted and Be it enacted by the said Lord
 Proprietary with the consent of the upper and
 lower house of this Assembly that there shall be
 an utter Abolition of all actions tending to be
 recover damages for any fault committed against
 anyone in his Lordships peace by any of the
 party who were in Rebellion against his Lord
 ships Governm^t here at any time between the
 Fifteenth of February one thousand six hundred
 forty four and the fifth of August one thousand
 six hundred forty six excepting Richard
 Ingle & John Durford Members and such
 others of the Isle of Kent as were not pardoned
 by His Lordships brother Leonard Salvent Esq^r deceased
 His Lordships late Lieutenant of this Province
 And likewise of all actions tending to recover
 Price for any goods or labour employed during
 the said time for the defence of the country—
 And Be it further enacted by the authority &
 consent aforesaid that no contracts made with
 the said party then in Rebellion against the
 Governm^t or any person of that party to the
 use maintenance or behoofe of the said Rebell
 ion shall be actionable in any court of his Lord
 ships And that all contracts other then when the
 true owner was party the matter whereof was
 any plundered goods or cattle shall be void in
 Law And all such price as have been received
 for any of them by the wrongfull possessor shall
 be
