An Act For appointing Coronors in each respective County

30 Whereas there have many Inconveniencies happen-  
ed in this Province for want of appointing Coronors  
in each County Be it therefore enacted by the right  
Hon.<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary of this Province with  
the assent of the upper and lower house of this  
Generall Assembly that the Hon.<sup>ble</sup> the Lieutenant Generall  
for the time being doe constitute and appoint such  
person or persons from time to time to be coronors as  
he shall Judge most able and best qualified for that  
office in each respective County in this Province  
And Be it further enacted that the Lieutenant Gen-  
erall give out Commission to such persons to the intent  
and purpose as aforesaid and that the same as near  
as may bee may concur with the laws and constitutions  
of England and that an oath be administered to  
every such coronor by appointment of the Lieutenant  
Generall at their entering in to the said Office accord-  
ing to the forme of the oath of a coronor in England

An Act For confirmation of the Articles of Peace  
made with the Indians

Whereas By Articles of peace drawn and concluded  
on by the grand Committee of both houses of this pres-  
ent Generall Assembly and the twentieth day of April  
one thousand six hundred sixty six Signed by  
the Hon.<sup>ble</sup> the Governour and as many of the great  
men of Pascattaway Anacostanck Doages Mitiki  
woman Manasquesend Mattanoman Chingwa  
wateich nangemaich Portoback Sacayo pangayo  
and Choptico as were present with a limitation of  
time for the absents to come in and signe the said  
Articles a firme peace and amity was concluded  
on
