In most humble wise Complaining humbly
Sheweth John Jarbo of Lyon in the Realm of France
Augustine Heuman of Prague in the Kingdom of
Bohemia Ephraim Georgius and Gasparus Sons to the
said Augustine Anna Margarita Judith & Francina
his daughters Anna Back George and Peter her
Sons that whereas the said John Jarbo was borne
at Lyon in France and whereas the said Augus-
tine Heuman was borne at Prague in Bohemia
And that Ephraim Georgius Gasparus Anna
Margarita Judith & Francina his Sons and
daughters were borne at New York out of the Lim-
its of this Province, and that Anna Back borne
at Amsterdam in Holland George & Peter her
Sons borne at Accomack in Virginia have long
there Inhabited and now removed into this Pro-
vince hath for many years inhabited ^{with} in this Pro-
vince invited hither by and Confidence of Your
Lordships Declaration of the Second of July 1649
wherby You did empower Your Governour from
time to time to grant Lands unto any persons of
French Dutch or Italian descent in the same and
as ample manner and upon the same termes &
provisoes as they were thereby empowered to grant
Land to any person or persons of British or Irish
Descent and during there said abode within
this Province have been allwayes faithfull and
obedient unto Your Lordships Laws yett for that
both hee and the rest of Your Lordships Orators
are not of British or Irish descent they cannot take
benefitt of Laws and customes of this Province
as other the good people of this Province of British
or Irish descent may to their great losse prejudice
and hinderance as alsoe to the deterring of divers
others of the Foreign Nations aforesaid from
Comeing into this Province and by consequence
prestriving the peopling of this Province
