 Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary with the advice and
 Consent of this present Generall Assembly that
 from hence forward all the acts that shall pass
 from this and all other succeeding Assemblies
 shall be from time to time faithfully transcribed
 into parchment and by writt under the great
 Seal of this Province from time to time to be passed
 by the Chancellour for the time then being to the
 Sheriffe of each respective County be transmitted
 and Commandment to them in the said writts
 shall be given as well the said acts in their severall
 and respective Counties in what places to
 them shall seem most convenient to publish and
 proclame as the said acts of Assembly to see
 firmly observed and kept and Be it further
 Enacted that every severall and respective County
 shall from time to time pay unto the Chancellour
 for the time then being for such transcript of the
 Lawes and writt under the great Seal as aforesaid
 the sume of two thousand pounds of Tobacco

An Act For the continuance of peace with and
 protecon of our Neighbours and confederate Indians
 in Choptank River

 league with us and for their Friendship to us are
 in danger to be destroyed by there Neighbour
 Nations our enemies And whereas Abasco Hat
 Sawapp and Sequassimo have of late given
 large testimonies of their Fidelity towards us
 in delivering up the Murderer of Capt^t John
 Odber
