or intended to be bound and likewise that every such Master Captain and Commander who shall from & after the said twenty ninth day of September which shall be in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred Sixty nine Sayle or Neglect to give such notice or to Ship freight take on board loads store and transport such goods & Commodities of his said Lordship his heirs or assignes Lord and Proprietary Lords and People of this Province or such his or their Governour or Governours of this Province for the time being or shall refuse to give such bills of Lading as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of this present act shall for every such offence forfeit the sume of ten pounds Sterling for every tunc so refused to the Lord and Proprietary or Lords and Proprietaries of this Province to be recovered in the Provinciall Court of this Province and that untill the said forfeiture shall be recovered and satisfied it shall and may be lawful to and for his said Lordship his heirs or assignes Lord and Proprietary or Lords and Proprietaries of this Province or his or their Governour or Governours of this Province for the time being to seize or detain such Ship or vessel of which such master Captain or Commander shall be master Captain or Command or with all her guns Tackle furniture or apparell whatsoever this act to endure for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen
