Seavy and Seize or take the goods and Chattells of
any Inhabitant within this Province that
shall be then Present or absent as aforesaid so
far as to deprive them of all livelihood for the future
but that some for necessary maintenance Bedding
gunnare spott and necessary Labourers tooles
with such like household impliments and Con-
-union for subsistence shall be protected from
all such attachments and Executions so long as he
or they shall Inhabite within this Province and
43 provided also that such as shall be found by proof
or other Circumstance willfully to absent themselves
into the woods or else where from the Sherifes sight
whereby they cannot be found to be brought to a legall
and such also as shall be intended to depart or fly
out of the Province (to be evenced upon oath) shall
have no benefitt of this Law but that an attachment
or Execution may issue forth on all or any of his or
their goods or Chattells This act to endure for three
Yeares or to the end of the next Generall Assembly
which shall first happen
