the wooden measures and three other Stamps for the  
pewter measures to be all of the same Letter with their  
other Stamps And that the said weights measures  
and Stamps be kept by the respective persons aforesaid  
named at their aforesaid houses whether all persons  
are to bring their Stillyards to be tried Stamped and  
numbered once a year also their Barrels which are  
to contayn five Bushells and other measures to be sealed  
And all persons selling by other weights or measures  
are not tryed Stamped numbered and sealed as aforesaid  
Shall forfeit one thousand pounds of Tobacco for every  
default the one half to the Lord Proprietary the other  
half to the informer to be recovered in any Court of Record  
within this province And it is further enacted by  
the authority aforesaid that no Stillyards that carries  
gross weight shall be admitted or stamp'd at any  
Standard within this province and in consideracion  
of the trouble paines and charge which the person  
aforenamed must use and bear in performing this  
Office It is hereby further enacted by the authority  
aforesaid that every person or persons for every  
time that any persons shall have their Stillyards &  
peec tryed Stamped and numbered shall pay unto  
such person that shall have the keeping of the said  
Standard the sume of two Shillings <sup>and six pence</sup> for  
every wooden and Pewter measure markt and if  
any person without Just cause shall trouble an  
other to try his Stillyards after stamp'd and num  
bered by the Standard such person shall pay and  
statisfie the fee to the officer so due as aforesaid And  
it is hereby further enacted by the authority aforesaid  
that one thousand six hundred pounds of Tobacco  
be this present Year leavyed in every severall land  
respective Counties within this province to be  
paid this Cropp now ensuing unto each res  
pective person aforenamed for the purchasing of  
the aforesaid weights measures and other the mate  
rials
