Materialls And in case the same is not sufficient
to purchase the same after a just account delivered
into the Commissioners of each respective County of
the first penny in England with all other distur-
ments which will accrue thereby allowing one
penny for every pound of Tobacco then the said
Commissioners hereby are enjoined to tax so much
as shall be wanting thereof in the ensuing
County Levy And if in case the said Summe of
Sixteen hundred pounds of Tobacco will overpay
their said disturments at one penny per pound
then such person or persons are to be accountable
for the overplus (the excess that shall ensue the Ar-
rival of the said goods to the County that shall
disturbse the same and if in case any of the persons
afore named shall make default of procuring and
purchasing such weights measures Seals Stampes
and numbers as by this act they are enjoined by
the time before limited the said person or persons
shall be fined three thousand pounds of one half
thereof to the Lord Proprietary and the other half to
the County where such default shall be made and
where the same shall be recovered by bill plaint or
Information whereⁿ no Escoyn Protection or wagen
of law to be allowed and in case of the death of
any of the persons afore in this act named to
provide the weights and measures and for keep-
ing the Standard aforesaid the severall and
respective Commissioners of each Respective County
Court shall from time to time nominate and
appoint such other person or persons in their
severall and respective Counties to keep the said
severall standards in such convenient place in
the County as they shall think fitt this Act to
endure for three years or to the end of the next
Generall Assembly which shall first happen
