


of the said Freemen in open assembly first had
 and obtained and that during the continuance of
 this act as aforesaid the last clause of an act Intituled
 an act concerning levying war within this Province
 by which clause it is enacted that all charges arise
 ing from time to time by defence of this Province
 against any Invasion of any Enemy or Enemies
 against any domestic Insurrections or rebellions
 against the publick peace of this Province or the
 Government Established herein and under the said
 Proprietary and his heirs Lords and Proprietaries
 of this Province shall be defrayed by the Province
 by an equall assessment upon the persons and Estates
 of the Inhabitants thereof shall be and remaine dis-
 pended any thing in that act to the contrary Not
 withstanding The foregoing clauses in the said
 act Remaing still in full force and vertue
 Provided alsoe that so long as this act shall con-
 tinue his said Lordship his Heir^{or} or Receivers Generall
 for the time being shall receive good Sound and
 Marchantable Tobacco when tendered for his said
 Lordships Duties or fines for Alienacion of Lands
 reserved upon this severall and respective Grants
 of Land in this Province at the rate of two pence
 per pound any thing in his said Lordship Grants
 to the contrary hereby notwithstanding provided
 also and it is hereby enacted By the right Hon^{ble}
 the Lord Proprietary by and with the consent of
 the upper and lower houses of this present Generall
 Assembly that the act Intituled an act for the
 Muster master Generalls fee be and for ever hence
 forth stand Repealed This act to continue
 during the naturall life of the right Hon^{ble} Julius
 now Lord and Proprietary of this Province and
 for one yeere more next after his decease and noe
 longer
