An Act For the killing of Wolves

Be it Enacted By the right Hon^{ble} the said Proprietary by an Act with the advice and consent of this present Gen^l Assembly That every person who shall bring the head of a wolfe to any of the Commissioners or Justices of the peace in any County of this Province shall be allowed two hundred pounds of Tobacco from the Treasury where the wolfe shall be killed and that such Commissioner or Justice of the peace to whom the wolfe head shall be brought shall cutt or cause to be cutt out the Tongue and cutt or cause to be cutt off the ears of the said wolfe head to prevent the deceit of twice or oftner paying for the same This act to continue for three years or to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly which shall first happen And be it further Enacted that all other acts formerly made for the killing of Wolves be and are hereby Repealed

An Act For the preservation of Orphans Estates

Finds much as the former laws made in this Province concerning Orphans Estates are found by experience to be very defective & no ways sufficient for the preservation of Orphans Estates according to the ends and purposes thereby intended & desired The Delegates in this present Assembly now assembled pray that it may be Enacted And Be it Enacted by the right honourable the said Proprietary of this Province with the advice and consent of the upper and lower house of this present Gen^l Assembly and the authority of the same That all last Wills and testaments shall be firme and inviolable unless the Executor or Overseers thereby appointed doe refuse to Execute the trust in them reposed by the testator in which case the chief Judge for probate of wills and granting administration shall grant Administration with the
