this Province and by consequence for sloowing the
peopling of this Province with usefull artificers &
handycrafts men May it therefore please Your
Lordshipps of your abundant goodness and wont too
care of and over this Province That it may be Enac
ted and ordeneed And be it ordeneed and enacted by
the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary of this Pro
vince by and with the advise & consent of the up
per and lower houses of this present Generall As
sembly and the authority of the same that your
Lordships humble petition or Matthias Decosta
shall and may from hence forth be adjudged re
puted and taken as a Naturall borne person within
this Province of Maryland and also that he shall &
may from hence forth by the same authority be enabled
and adjudged to all intents and purposes able to de
mand Challenge as he have hold and enjoy any
lands tenements Hereditaments and rents within
this Province as heir or heirs to any of his ancestors by
reason of any discont fee simple fee tayle Generall or
Speciall or Remainder upon any Estate tayle or
come to him by any discont in fee simple fee tayle
generall or Speciall or Remainder upon any Estate
tayle as aforesaid or by any other Lawfull Conveyance
or Conveyances or means whatsoever as if he had
been borne within this Province or were of British
or Irish dissent as aforesaid And also that he from
hence forth may and shall be enabled to prosecute
maintaine
