Misdemeanors committed in their severall Counties against his Lordship's peace doo humbly pray that it may be enacted And be it By the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary by and with the advice and consent of the upper and lower houses of this present Generall Assembly & authority of the same enacted that from and after the publicacon hereof all and every person or persons that shall hereafter be summoned by the severall Sheriffs within this Province to appear in the severall County Courts as grand Inquests to inquire as aforesaid shall bear and defray the expence & charge of his and their own severall attendances at such County Courts without charging any thing upon the severall Counties for such their charges and attendance and to the end no person may be overburthened hereby It is further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no person shall be twice summoned in one yeer to be one of the said grand Inquest and that the Sherifes aforesaid shall not cause any person to be summoned and Impannelled to serve upon any ^{said} grand Inquest but such as shall be freeholders in their severall & respective Counties this act to endure for three yeeres or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen

An Act For the Surveyor Generalls fees with addicon of fees upon Presureways and for leavying the same

Forasmuch as the severall Lawes hitherto made for the regulateing of Surveyors fees have by daily experience been found ineffectuall to curb the exorbitant Exacons of the severall Deputy Surveyors to the great damage, detriment & vexacon of the good people of this Province
Be it therefore enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary by and with the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present Genll Assembly that from and after the publicacon hereof the Surveyor Generall or any of his Deputy's for the time being shall ask demand take or Receive
