And be it further Enacted by the authority afo-
said that the Surveyor Generall or his deputy shall
keep a book of all the surveys that he or they shall
make together with faire plotts of the same and
the said books kept by the Deputyes Respectively
shall be yearly returned to the Surveyor Generall
and in case the Surveyor Generall or his deputy or
deputies shall Neglect to keep such books as aforesd
whereby any person within this Province shall
suffer damage by the lose of his land survey or otherwise

Be it further Enacted that the said Surveyor Gen-
erall his deputy or deputies in whom the fault
shall be found to be shall be liable to satisfy all
such damages as shall be adjudged against him
in the Provinciaall Court in which Court only the
said damage shall be tryed & for the avoiding
of all Contests between the Surveyors & the people of
this Province

Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid that the
Surveyor Generall or his deputy or deputies Res-
pectively shall before he or they demand his fees
be bound to deliver a certificate of his Survey to the
parties for whom he Surveyed the Land and that
the said parties deliver the same into the office ac-
cording to his warrant this act to Repeal all
other Laws concerning Surveyors fees and to con-
tinue for the 22 years or to the end of the next Gener-
all Assembly which shall first happen

An Act For the payment of fees due from
